- ☒ Stay Sensitive to the Holy Spirit's Leading.

ACTION STEP: Obey quickly when the Spirit nudges you—especially when it feels small.

- ☒ See Jesus as God's Salvation, Not Just a Seasonal Theme.

ACTION STEP: Make worship the center of your Advent practices, not the background noise.

- ☒ Embrace the Call to Lifelong Obedience and Service
